Acis delivers more new homes

Work has been completed on 32 brand new affordable homes in the towns of Epworth and Bolsover after Lincolnshire based housing association Acis Group handed over the keys to their latest new homes developments.

Acis, who own and manage over 5,000 homes across Lincolnshire, Nottinghamshire and South Yorkshire, handed keys to the new residents of their developments in the North Lincolnshire town of Epworth and the Derbyshire town of Bolsover in May.

The Epworth scheme at Axholme Road has created 12 affordable homes and was constructed by Redbourne Homes. The project features a mix of two and three bedroom houses, with seven available for rent and five available for rent to own, where customers can rent now and buy later.

The Bolsover scheme, constructed by Westleigh Developments, has seen 18 two, three and four bedroom homes built off Shuttlewood Road and an existing four bedroom home converted into 2 two bedroom apartments. This comes after Acis received £1.3m worth of funding for the project from the Homes and Communities Agency, as part of the National Affordable Housing Programme. 18 of the properties are available for rent and the remaining two are available under the rent to own scheme.

Russ Blenkinsop, Finance Director at Acis Group, said:

“These investments represent our commitment to the residents of Epworth and Bolsover. We pride ourselves in putting people first and providing better places for people to live. These new homes mean that we can help meet the growing demand for high quality affordable homes in these areas. Working together with Redbourne and Westleigh have been exciting partnerships and has ensured that we’ve provided a high quality product for our customers.”
