



## **Not in my Neighbourhood Week**

Not in my Neighbourhood Week (NIMNW) ran from the 2<sup>nd</sup> to the 6<sup>th</sup> of November. Now in its third year, NIMNW continues to be a great opportunity for local agencies, police forces and partners to showcase the work they do. The key objective is to inform local people of action taking place in their area to tackle crime and anti-social behaviour and to make their communities safer.

NIMNW aims to:

- Increase awareness among the local community of what the police and local agencies do to tackle crime and anti-social behaviour
- Increase public confidence in the work the police and local agencies are doing to tackle crime and anti-social behaviour and make communities safer
- Encourage the public to engage with the police and local agencies and play their part in tackling crime and anti-social behaviour
- Engage local and regional media and encourage them to support the work being done locally

Activities for NIMNW were co-ordinated by our ASB team in partnership with Lincolnshire Police. Other agencies involved in the week were West Lindsey District Council, Trading Standards, Fire and Rescue, Youth Crime Prevention, Addaction and Age Concern.

Staff time was committed by both the ASB and Neighbourhoods teams throughout the week. A variety of locations were visited including Morton, Scotter, Market Rasen and Gainsborough. A double decker red bus was booked for some of the duration of NIMNW and was used in each location for the agencies to work from.
