Richard Barker, RIBA, was born in Birmingham and lived and worked in the Midlands until 2000 when he moved with his family to Lincolnshire.

He was educated at Warwick School and Birmingham School of Architecture where he qualified as a Chartered Architect in 1966.

He was Senior Partner in his own practice from 1969 until 1995 when he sold out and joined the Board of TPS Consult - part of Tarmac Professional Services, a division of Tarmac plc. He was Regional Director for the Midlands and responsible for the Scottish office and the Architectural Division of the London operation. He retired in 1999.

Since moving to Lincolnshire he was appointed an Independent member of the East Lindsey District Council's Standards Committee in 2002. In 2004 he was elected Chairman of the Standards Committee and continues to hold this position.

In 2007 he was appointed Chairman of the Horncastle Town Plan Steering Group. He is Chairman of a Residents Board of Management based in Conningsby.

In his younger days he was Warwickshire County Squash Champion and represented his county, Warwickshire, at tennis. He also represented the Public Schools at Tennis and Warwickshire Young Amateurs at Cricket.
