### **Acis extends Grimsby portfolio**

Lincolnshire based housing association Acis Group recently extended their portfolio by welcoming 15 brand new properties into their housing stock.

The properties on Robert Pearson Mews in Grimsby were handed over to Acis by developer Stamford Homes on 18 March. They consist of two and three bedroom houses, with eight available for rent and seven presented on a rent to own basis, where customers can rent now and buy later.

Russ Blenkinsop, Finance Director for Acis, said:

“We are progressing with our growth strategy by adding new properties to the Acis portfolio. In developing our range of homes we take into consideration the changing markets in which we operate and the needs of our customers.”

The Acis properties are part of the new Clee Fields Court development, off Ladysmith Road, which contains a total of 68 rented, rent to own and private homes. Acis obtained support for the project from the Homes and Communities Agency via part funding.

Russ added:

“We have ensured that a variety of property types and tenures have been included in the development. This shows our commitment to providing more homes for more people and ensuring that those in housing need are provided with a choice of home that meets their aspirations. Acis prides itself in putting people first and providing better places for people to live and I believe Robert Person Mews meets this criteria. We look forward to welcoming new customers in Grimsby.”

Acis owns and manages over 5,000 homes across Lincolnshire, Nottinghamshire and South Yorkshire, and will be further establishing a presence in North East

Lincolnshire with the development of 33 new properties on Frederick Street which are due for completion in 2012.
