

# Mobility Scooters

So if you own a scooter you will need to **ask for permission** to store it before you move in. Space is limited and unfortunately it is on a first come first served basis.

# Request for permission to store and charge a mobility scooter

**This must be made and authorised before a tenancy agreement is signed.**

There is provision to charge scooters in an allocated safe area. This is limited and is allocated on a first come, first served basis. At viewing we will be able to tell you if there is any space available, before you make a decision to sign the tenancy agreement.

## **Tenant responsibility**

All scooters must be stored in the provided facility and have current electrical safety test certificates, liability insurance and ensure that the battery is a sealed unit designed to be charged in an unventilated enclosed area. There is a charge to pay for electricity and the provision of the space.
