#### **Privacy statement**

Acis Group Limited (Acis) is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. We think it is extremely important to keep any personal information we have about you secure and confidential and in accordance with Data Protection Legislation including the Data Protection Act and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), as amended from time to time.

We share your name and contact details across the Acis group of companies and with our suppliers and partners in order to deliver our services to you. We only share your detailed personal information (including sensitive personal information) so that we can service your needs and our legitimate business needs. We may share this information with suppliers and partners for reasons including (but not limited to) providing services to you, for the collection of debts and taxes, and for the prevention, detection and prosecution of crime. ### Our process for considering your application

Once we have received your application, we will:

- Check whether your tenancy and the property is eligible to be exchanged
- If eligible, carry out a home visit to the Acis property
- Review a reference from the non Acis landlord (if applicable)

We will look carefully if we are able to grant permission for the mutual exchange to go ahead. Consent cannot be given if:

- Any Acis tenant(s) are not on a five-year fixed term or assured tenancy
- There are any exception criteria in place which mean we cannot agree an exchange. For example, it is designated for older people
- Adaptations have been installed and no one in the proposed household has a need for the specialist adaptations
- The exchange would mean the property would be over-occupied
- The exchange would mean the property would be significantly under occupied
- Any party is subject to a court order in relation to their tenancy
- Any party has been served a notice in relation to their tenancy

This list is not exhaustive but intended to give an indication of the main reasons why we cannot give permission for an exchange to go ahead.

Other things to consider:

- Depending on the type of tenancy you and your exchange partner have, you may lose the security of tenure. You will be given further information about this before you finalise the exchange.
- We will require any remedial works to be completed on any Acis property to bring it to our lettable standard
- Any debts related to the tenancy will need to be cleared for the exchange to go ahead
- Any fixtures and fittings which are related to the property must be left in the property even if you fitted them
- Photo ID will be required of all parties wishing to exchange
- By going ahead with the exchange, you will be accepting the property in its current condition and liability for any breaches of tenancy
- Should any party in the exchange decide to end their tenancy or does not want to go ahead, we will cancel the application

## Right to appeal

If you are unhappy with the decision we make, you have the right to appeal. Your Acis contact can advise you how to do this.
